The Narrative 4 Empathy School Award recognises post primary schools that foster an environment of empathy, lead with kindness, and cultivate connection and understanding in their students and staff.

About us

Narrative 4 is an empathy education programme that started in high schools in the U.S. and now runs in over 5 countries. Narrative 4 was established to address isolation in young people by creating a space for young people to connect and share their own stories and experiences with each other. This helps them to see the world from another's perspective so that they can understand themselves and other people better. Storytelling is a powerful tool that allows us to

see the commonality of human experience. N4 trains teachers in an evidence-based teaching method that fosters connection, empathy and encourages positive relationships in the classroom. In 2016, Narrative 4 Ireland replicated the US model and began running the programme in Ireland. The programme was developed under the guidelines for the National Council for Curriculum & Assessment (NCCA) Junior Cycle Wellbeing Unit.

As well as the award itself, gold awardee schools will be rewarded with books and artist visits
